

FREDERICK-FIRESTONE FIRE DISTRICT

The Frederick-Firestone Fire District serves the residents, businesses and visitors of the Towns of Frederick and Firestone, and areas of unincorporated Weld County.

As a specal district, the Fire District is always getting questions about how it is different than a metro district. Below is information on the two types of Districts.

FIRE DISTRICTS:

- As a special district, the Frederick-Firestone Fire District, provides emergency services that include fire, rescue, and medical (ambulance) transport.
- Fire districts are funded off of property taxes only.
- While Fire Districts use fire hydrants in the event of an emergency, we do not own or maintain them.
- The average Fire District in the area is 10-17 Mills in taxes.

METRO DISTRICTS:

- Metro Districts pay for infrastructure and amenities within the subdivision or neighborhood you live in.
- Metro District taxes are related directly to your subdivision not the Fire District which serves you.
- Metro District taxes list fire protection, which is for the infrastructure of fire hydrants in your subdivision only.
- The average Metro District in the area is 50-75 Mills in taxes.
